GUIDELINES FOR THE END SEMESTER EXAMINATIONS: MAY- JUNE 2025

- 1. Checklist for appearing in examinations
 - College ID
 - Hall Ticket
 - Black Ball point pens (2)
 - Calculator (without cover)
- 2. Make sure you occupy the correct seat, at least 10 to 15 minutes before the commencement of the examination and fill the correct seat number and other details in the space provided in the answerbook
- 3. If you have forgotten your hall ticket, then
 - If you are an FE or BE student, download a copy of the hall ticket, get it stamped from the exam cell (II floor)
 - If you are an SE or TE student, obtain a duplicate of your hall ticket from the exam cell (II floor), by paying the necessary charges
- 4. If you have forgotten your ID card, then
 - Write a letter addressed to the Senior Supervisor, requesting you to be allowed for that exam and get it stamped from the Senior Supervisor (Fr. Bosco Hall, II floor A wing)
- 5. In case you have completed answering your paper, you will be allowed to leave the exam hall only after the lapse of one hour after the commencement of the examination.
- 6. All candidates who do not sit through the entire duration of the examination, will have to submit their question papers along with the answer sheets.

- 7. In the exam hall, you are not allowed to bring
 - Bus/train tickets/passes
 - Mobile phones/Smart watches
 - Writing pads
 - Notes/material related or unrelated to the examination
- 8. Maintain silence, sit straight and concentrate on writing your paper
- 9. A warning bell will ring 10 minutes before the end of the exam.
 - You will not be allowed to submit your answer book and leave the exam hall after that warning bell. You will have to wait till the final bell for that
 - You will not be getting supplements after that warning bell
- 10. Please attempt the paper in the best way you can, without indulging in any unfair means. Please note that action for cheating in exam will be taken based on University Rules which may be annulling (making null and void) the entire semester.
