- The event was publicized in a creative way on social platforms which increased participation.

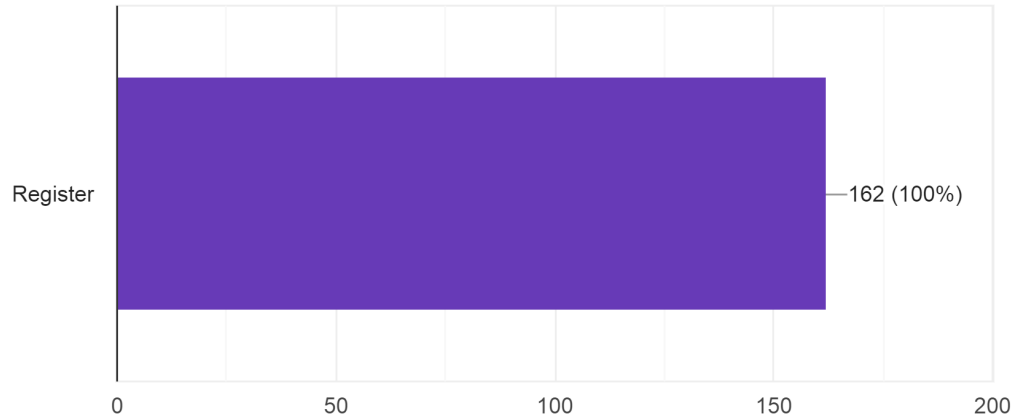
### Individual learning in organising the event

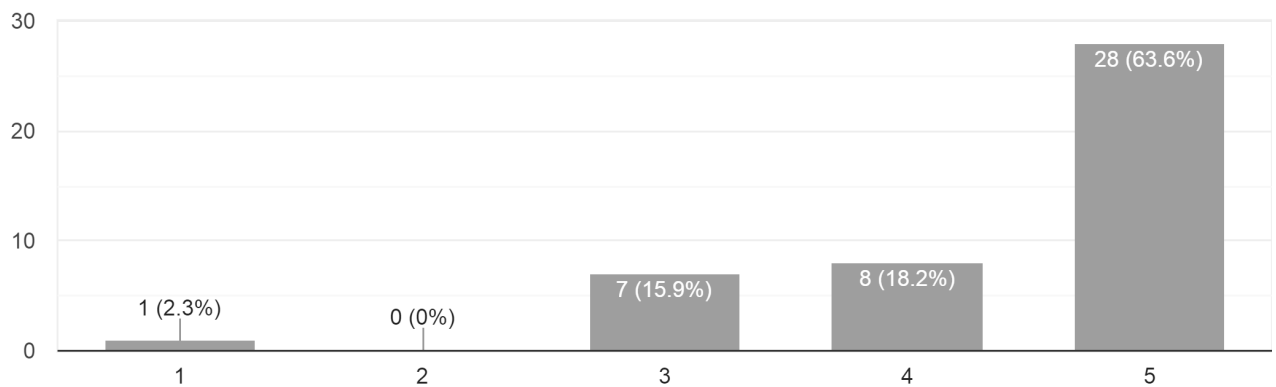

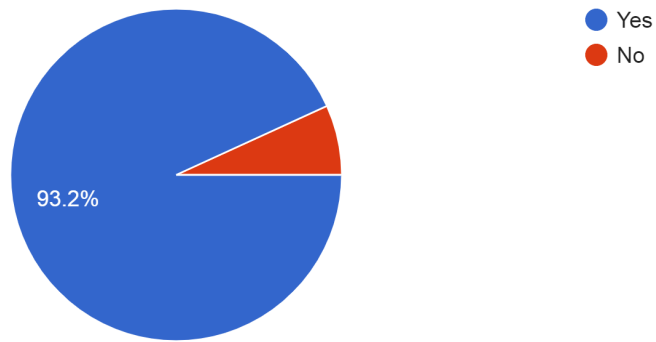

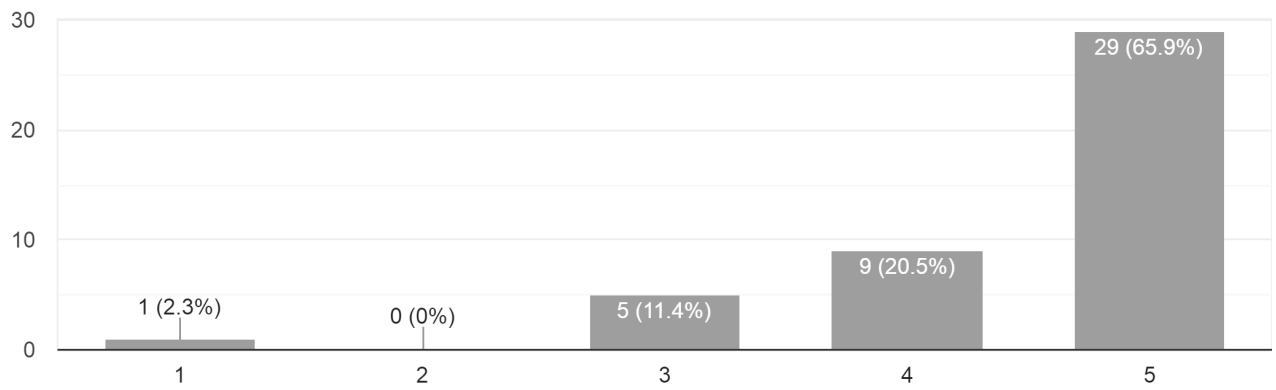

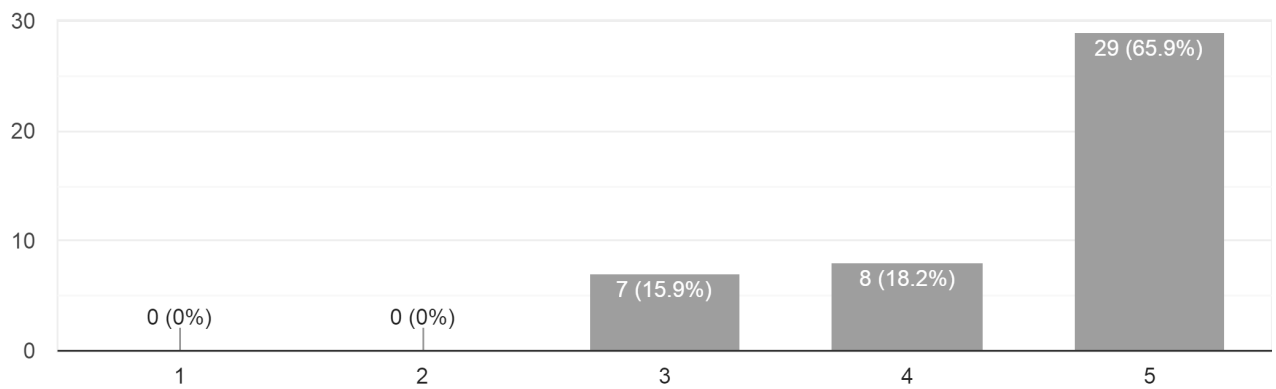
